Summary of STEM Concepts & Principles Underlying the Overall Plan If I create a digital support group for kids who have incarcerated parents that is safe and supportive, then these kids will find the support and understanding of what it is like to have a parent in prison. To create this I need to know the STEM concepts of a digital database so I started to research the coding about Facebook.

Facebook uses several different languages for its different services. PHP is used for the front-end, Erlang is used for Chat, Java and C++ are also used in several places (and perhaps other languages as well). Thrift is an internally developed cross-language framework that ties all of these different languages together, making it possible for them to talk to each other. This has made it much easier for Facebook to keep up its

cross-language development. Facebook operates, several traditional approaches to serving web content break down or simply aren't practical.

Facebook still uses PHP to this day. So I need to learn how to work PHP so when I make my support site in case any bugs or viruses attack I will know what to do and personally I think I need to learn more about coding .(Singh, 2021)


